MEDITERRANEAN OFFICE FOR YOUTH

- ❖ In recognition of the fact that **circular migration for educational purposes is a decisive factor in the development of wealth, intercultural exchange, and mutual understanding in the Mediterranean region,**
16 countries bordering the Mediterranean have come together to make young people a priority in the construction of a Mediterranean area for the circulation of persons, knowledge, and skills. Their joint endeavour is known as the Mediterranean Office for Youth.
- ❖ The 16 countries are:
Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, Cyprus, Egypt, France, Greece, Italy, Lebanon, Malta, Montenegro, Morocco, Slovenia, Spain, Tunisia, and Turkey.



Two missions:

1. Pilot programme for mobility of students and young professionals

To promote:

- Mobility for top students enrolled in Master- and PhD-level programmes
- initial work experience
- deployment of newly acquired skills to benefit students' countries of origin

2. The Resource centre on Mediterranean mobility

Pilot programme for mobility of students and young professionals

Encourages structured partnerships among institutions of higher education in MOY countries so as to be able to offer their best students the MOY label:

- A **MOY grant** to fund a period of academic mobility lasting 1–2 semesters in the course of a MOY-labelled Master- or PhD-level programme
- **Facilitation of entry and residency procedures**
- **Career mentoring**
- Access to an **internship and employment platform**
- The opportunity to gain **initial professional experience** in the country of one's choice

Call for projects for MOY labelling of programmes

To be eligible, a programme must meet all of the following conditions:

- It must be a Master- or PhD-level programme.
- It must offer joint or multiple degrees: one joint degree, two or more degrees (one from each participating institution).
- It must be implemented by institutions from MOY-member countries. The institutions must be organized into a partnership that includes at least two different countries.
- It must be in at least one of the 13 fields of Mediterranean interest.

13 Fields of Mediterranean interest

Chosen following analysis of the labour markets, skill needs, and strategic priorities of participating countries

RESULTS OF THE 1st CALL FOR PROJECTS

Step 1 : Labelling of Master and PhD programmes

- The MOY labelled 41 joint programmes offered by nearly 100 institutions of higher education from 12 countries (33 Masters, 8 PhDs)
- Programmes must operate in 1 of the 13 fields of interests to the countries of the region, with priority given to the 6 areas identified by the Union for the Mediterranean.
- MOY label is decided by a College of 11 international experts designated by participating countries

RESULTS OF THE 1st CALL FOR PROJECTS

Step 2 : Selection of students to receive a MOY scholarship

- MOY mobility Grants offered to 107 students from 10 different countries:

31 Tunisians, 21 Morrocans, 10 French, 10 Italians, 8 Egyptians, 8 Turkish, 6 Spanish, 6 Greeks, 5 libanese, 2 Montenegrins

= 93 grantees enrolled in a programme at a Master level, and 14 at the PhD level

- Countries hosting MOY grantees:

France (69), Spain (21), Italy (17), Greece (4), Morroco (3), Croatia (2), Turkey (1)

= **172 semesters of study abroad**, in a partner institution : 149 at the Master level, 23 at the PhD level

MOY Mobility Grants:

-1 or 2 semesters (5 or 10 months) of study or training

= **1000€/month for Master students - 1500€/month for Phd students**

(amounts adjusted according to the cost of living in the host country)

+ **300 € /semester of mobility for travel expenses**

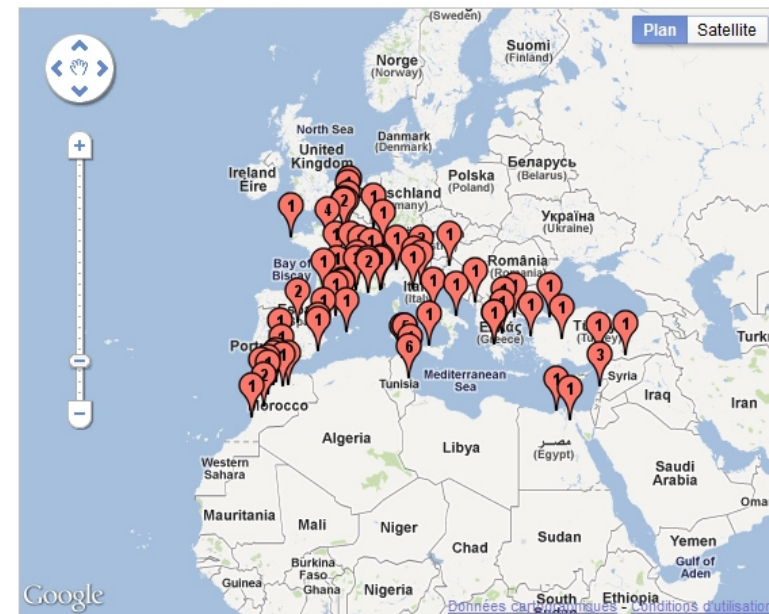

- Simultaneous launch of the call in 16 countries on **15 October 2011**
- Application packets available at www.mediterraneanofficeforyouth.org
- **31 January 2012:** Deadline for submission of applications to omj@campusfrance.org and to national operators in countries concerned (contact information on Web site)
- **February, 2012 :** Evaluation and selection process by College of Experts
- **March 2012:** Publication of list of labelled programmes by MOY General Secretariat
- **April 2012:** Partner Institutions select students candidates for MOY mobility grants.
- **June 2012:** Recipients of MOY mobility grants selected by the MOY College of Experts.
Publication of list by the MOY General Secretariat.
- **September–October 2012:** Beginning of academic year for MOY-labelled grantees.
